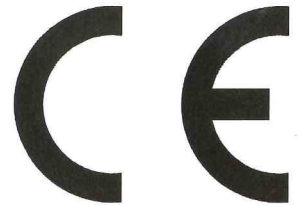

are applied and that the factory production control systems fulfils the prescribed requirements.
